Note to manufactured homeowners: The title to your manufactured home cannot be transferred unless all current year and delinquent personal property taxes are paid at the time of transfer.

SENIOR CITIZEN
PROPERTY TAX
DEFERRAL

The Senior Citizen Deferral Program provides a low-interest loan to senior citizens having difficulty paying property taxes. This is not a tax foregivness program, however, this program:

- Limits the maximum amount of property tax paid to 3% of total household income, and
- Ensures the amount of tax paid remains the same as long as you participate in this program. To be eligible, you must file an application by July 1, 2019, as well as:
 - 1. Be at least 65 years old,
 - 2. Have a household income of \$60,000 or less, and
 - 3. Have lived in your home for at least 15 years.
